


## Methodology

- 1,002 Ontarian adults were surveyed online using a representative panel.
- The survey was conducted from June 22 to 24, 2021
- The margin of error is +/- 3.1%, nineteen times out of twenty
  - Subgroups have larger margins of error
- The results have been weighted for accuracy by age, gender, region and past provincial vote using the most recent census data from Statistics Canada.



### Fairness of Equalization By Region





By Age, Gender and Home Ownership





#### By Education and Household Income


